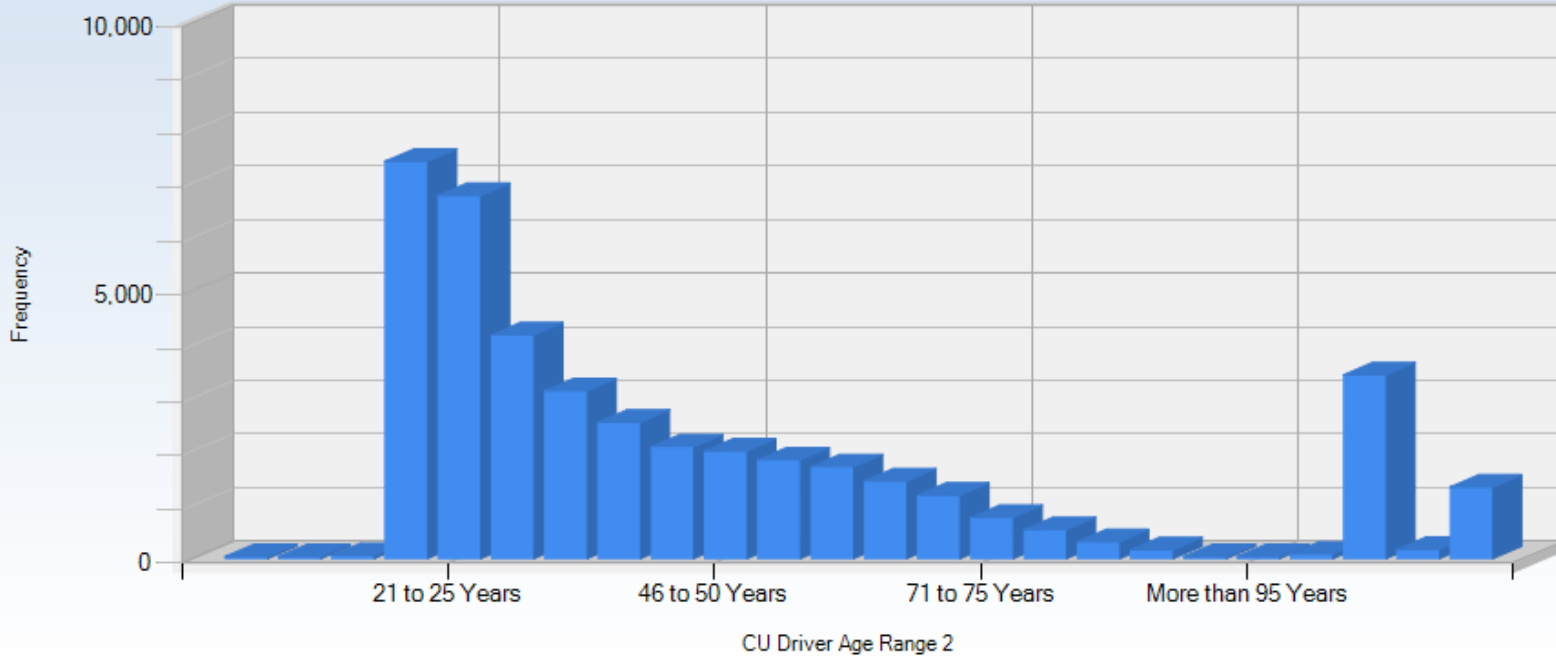

# Tuscaloosa County Crash Data (2016 - 2020)

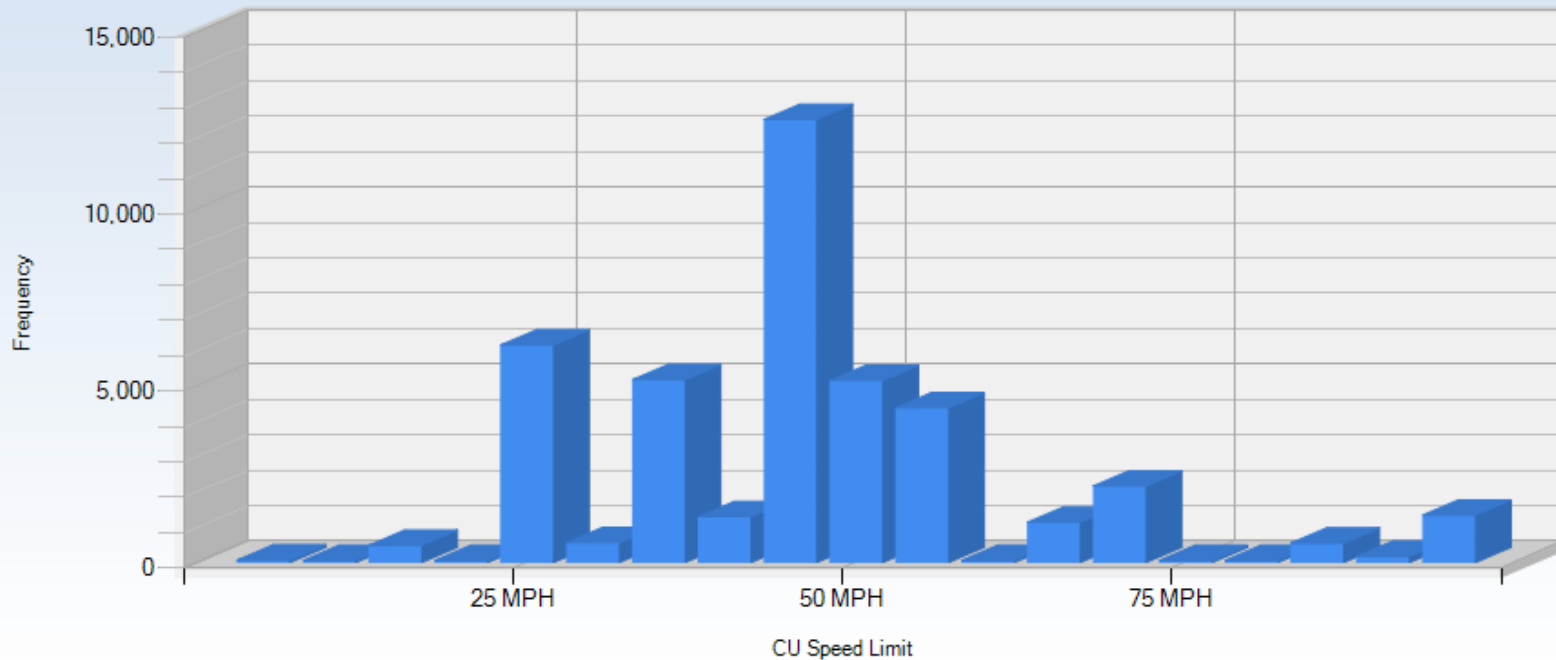
